


#### Director's Aug 2021 Report

- ✓ Assistant Director Mary Franklin attended MI-PR Group to learn about Instagram for library promotion.
- ✓ Staff Meeting: Aug 26, 2021. All in attendance. Learned customer service pointers, discussed circulation issues.
- $\checkmark$  New circulation assistant Ariana Hunt began employment on August 11.

#### 3. Collection Management and Development.

- ✓ Added: 1128 new physical items and 661 electronic items.
- ✓ Presently managing adult non-fiction books to remove items not circulated prior to 2017.

#### 4. Grants and Donations.

- ✓ 7/1/21 Application submitted to ECF Fund Grant for 8 T-Mobile hot-spots for educational purposes.
- ✓ 8/9/21 Application submitted to ECF Fund Grant for service for 3 T-Mobile hot-spots and 8 laptops for educational purposes.
- ✓ 8/23/21 Application submitted to FACF for a Circulation Grant for 2022.
- ✓ 8/25/21 Application submitted to FACF for a Summer Reading Grant for 2022.
- ✓ 8/30/21 Application submitted to Gerber Foundation for a 2022 Early Reader Collections grant.
- ✓ 8/30/21 LM ARPA Equipment Grant Request Update: LM is waiting for a supplemental appropriation bill from the Michigan legislature to proceed with the ARPA grants. They will notify every one of the review decisions and go forward with grant contracts for the approved applications as soon as the supplemental appropriations bill is passed.
- ✓ 9/1/21 MHC MiHope Grant award of \$10,000 for general support and humanities programming!
- ✓ 9/7/21 MCACA LowellArts Mini-grant update: MCACA cannot make grant award announcements until the State finalizes their FY22 budget. As soon as the FY22 State budget bill is signed, MCACA FY22 applicants will be contacted. Anticipated date will be early/mid to October.
- ✓ 2021 Summer Reading donations from area businesses and individuals was ≈\$4,742. Thank You!
