This year to support summer reading at NADL, Fremont Area Community Foundation donated \$5,650, and more than thirty-four local businesses and individuals donated toward Summer Reading prizes. Kids and teen prizes for reading include free pizza, ice cream, gourmet cookie, and finishers get a free book, Whitecaps tickets, and one-of-a-kind t-shirt while supplies last. Plus, they are entered into an end-of-summer prize drawing. Adults who join the program and read are entered into a prize drawing to be held at the end of August.




## **UPCOMING ACTIVITIES AT NEWAYGO LIBRARY**

Newaygo Area District Library will be closed today in observance of Independence Day.


