




PRESCHOOL STORYTIME: Tuesdays at 11 a.m. Three stories plus a craft are shared in the lower level.


## **COOKING WITH HONEY DEMONSTRATION:** Sat. May 11<sup>th</sup> 10:30 am – 12:30 pm


ADULT DROP IN: Mon. May 13th - Sat 18th




**ADULT BOOK CLUB:** Thurs. June  $6^{th}$  2:30 pm - 3:30 pm












































## 1. Library Staff Opportunities.
